A little bit of HISTORY

Did you know that in :

- 1871 The current brick church was built with a 165 foot high steeple
- 1900 Trolley lines installed in front of the church
- 1912 Durner Organ installed in the brick church
- 1917 Electric lights installed in sanctuary, hallways, and basement
- 1917 Ruben's "Descent from the Cross" painted behind the pulpit
- 1930 Stained glass windows installed in the sanctuary
- 1941 Organ repaired, electrified and improved
- 1942 Running water installed in the church
- 1950 Front concrete steps installed
- 1955 200 amp electrical service installed
- 1955 200th anniversary of the congregation celebrated
- 1956 The steeple is illuminated with night spot lights.

Our beautiful church sanctuary has been serving God in the Neffs community for 150 years. YES, this calls for a celebration here in 2022.


