Update from Pastor Kris, Consistory, and Church and Ministry Interim (Temporary) Plan for Pastor of Visitation Ministry

The Interim plan for covering the responsibilities for the Pastor of Visitation is going so well. Thank you everyone for your support in this transition. Thank you Carrie and Susan for becoming a wonderful part of our team. At the June Consistory meeting it was voted to extend this plan and change some of the hours and responsibilities based on our need to return to full coverage and the schedules of Carrie and Susan and their availability.

This plan will be effective August 1 and continue until May 1, 2023 (with 30 days' notice given by either party).

- 1. Carrie Beleno previous educator and school principal, Reiki Master, owner of healing center. Has led women's retreat days and meditation sessions here. Currently on Helping Hearts as a volunteer. Completed Clinical Pastoral Education (CPE) at St. Luke's in May (training required for chaplains and those seeking ordination). She will increase her hours to 10-12 hours/week.
- Focus on Visitation list, hospitals/follow up, call list shared with other pastors and other interim.
- Special focus organizing Helping Hearts and Communion Ministers for Flower and Communion deliveries and coordinate Golden Times program, assist with Sunday morning adult education, preaching 2 times in this 9 months.
- Emergency assistance as needed/negotiated with other Pastors
- Funerals assist for experience, cover only as needed/negotiated with other pastors
- Assisting in worship as time allows (monthly).
- **2. Susan Glosan** currently Moravian Seminary student, chaplaincy program. Has been active here in a variety of ways as musician, acolyte coordinator, and preacher. She will start Clinical Pastoral Education this August. Her hours will decrease to 2-3 hours/week.
- Focus on Visitation list, hospitals/follow up, call list shared with other pastors and interim
- Special focus preaching 2 times in this 9 months.
- Emergency assistance as needed/negotiated with other Pastors
- Funerals assist for experience, cover as needed/negotiated with other pastors
- Assisting in worship as time allows (monthly).

Our main goal is to support Pastors Kris and Kayli in their work as well as continue to provide ongoing pastoral care for our members.







June 2022 Consistory Actions:

These notes reflect items that needed action and approval by Consistory. Standing and routine items are reported by Committees and Staff throughout the newsletter. A complete copy of the Consistory minutes can be found in the church office.

This above request was given unanimous conditional approval.

FROM THE PROPERTY COMMITTEE

The focus the past few months has been on sharing information on the history of the current brick church built in 1871. Our brick church is blessed with 150 years of history and blessed with a caring and sharing congregation and community. God's spirit is all around this church property.

While we continue to celebrate the 150th anniversary of the brick church, we also look towards the future by making more improvements and upgrades to the church and the overall property.

This year's main project will be the repair and upgrade to the steeple. CJ Diirner & Sons from Ephrata will be returning to Neffs to perform this project, they are the firm who replaced the slate on the north side of the church last year. Their firm is highly qualified in working on tall church steeples in the local area and surrounding states.

They will be replacing damaged slates, repairing copper covers, copper valleys and step flashings, replace any damaged wood. The weathervane will be cleaned and repainted. All woodwork will be covered with high grade aluminum, which will eliminate future painting of the steeple woodwork.

This project is being funded through the Funds of Lasting Gifts endowment fund, along with special designated gifts from members and will bequests, which are being held in the Reserve Fund. We are grateful for everyone's support in this major project.

A second project will happen inside of the sanctuary as ESG Systems of Allentown arrives to make improvements and upgrades to the sound system and to the video system to provide improved streaming services of the Sunday services to families watching in their homes. This project is being funded through the Memorial Fund.
