FROM THE PROPERTY COMMITTEE

Union UCC's sanctuary is celebrating 150 years of serving God in the Neffs Community. This is quite an accomplishment, both for the congregation, and the 1871 brick church itself. Thus part of the reason for the June 18th celebration in the grove, inviting the congregation and the community to celebrate this milestone.

The faith and financial commitment of our ancestors over the past decades and centuries and our current members is remarkable, and part of the reason that we have such a beautiful place to worship and gather as a church family.

The Lutheran congregation moved into their new church facility in the year 2000, and the UCC congregation became sole caretaker of our current church property. Since that time, with the cooperation of the consistory, the property committee, the staff and the Funds of Lasting Gifts team, we have been able to make regular upgrades and improvements to the church sanctuary.

Included in this month's newsletter is a list of improvements that were made just to the sanctuary since 2000, with 90% of the funding for these projects coming from the Funds of Lasting Gifts endowment fund. Union UCC is truly blessed to keep our property in beautiful shape. Thank you donor families and FOLG trustees.

Looking back over the past 22 years, and looking at the long list of improvements that were made just to the sanctuary, we can all be proud of our accomplishments in working together to glorify God in keeping our church beautiful, updated, and inviting to all. I think the original designers and builders of the church in the 1870's would be proud of the care that was provided to their original work, withstanding the test of time in being the focal point of town, and has a bright future.

FROM THE MISSION COMMITTEE

Thank you for your generous support during the Easter Mission collection. Donations of over \$1,400 will support Meals on Wheels of the Lehigh Valley, and over \$1,400 will support the Miller-Keystone Blood Center. Both missions will provide love and support to local families, our financial support definitely makes a difference in the community.

Each year, earnings from the Urffer Fund in the Funds of Lasting Gifts is provided to missions outside of the church who deal with improving the lives of children. This year the Mission Committee approved \$720 to sponsor two young adult girls living in Zimbabwe, Africa, though the Church World Service program. The Special Olympics of the Lehigh Valley organization will r eceive \$1,000 for their children's sports programming, and \$927 will be provided to the Northeast Community Center Ministries in Bethlehem for their children's programs.


