New Online Camera and Sound Equipment for the Sanctuary The last 2 years have taught us so much. One thing our church staff and volunteers are learning about is how to include people in worship and our life when they can't be in the building. I have about 20 sermons on this topic to share at some point! To say it's been a learning curve is an understatement. BUT our pastors and staff and volunteers keep stepping up their game, willing to try new things and learn new things all the time. Our most recent upgrade is a new camera in the sanctuary which will be plugged directly into our sound system which should create better sound quality for those worshipping at home. The camera will also allow us to change the view of what's being seen at different points in the service. This upgrade also included installing a TV in the nursery so that people can be watching the service from there. All of these upgrades should improve the quality of online worship. Thanks for your grace and patience when we have problems and let us know what you think when we get things up and running.
