All: "I will instruct you and teach you in the way you should go; I will counsel you with my loving eye on you." Thank you God!


Education Hour for All Ages – Returns on September 11 9:15-10:15am


(Adult Class begins September 18) Children's Church – Returns September 18th during 10:30am Worship for ages 3-grade 5

Children will be in Room 7 (basement) and will return before worship is over. If worship ends early, parents are welcome to meet their children downstairs.






Scripture 1 Timothy 1: 12-17




