#### Welcome

*Leader:* During the last 4 weeks in our worship series on change, we have been reminded that our Creator God made us for change, that we are being made new always from the inside-out, and that our job sometimes is just to let go into trust that God is with us through the loss and rediscovery that is this process of change.




