The exterior of the New Beginning addition is being painted. The three oak trees in front of the sanctuary have been pruned, with dead branches removed. The bulbs in the emergency lights that operate when the generator turns on are being replaced, to be ready in case of a power outage. A new locking system will be installed on the basement entrance door to match the two entrance doors on the main level.

These projects are funded through the Funds of Lasting Gift endowment fund.

The Allentown Rescue Mission

For more than a century, the Allentown Rescue Mission has addressed the changing face of homelessness, tackling the root causes of homelessness, and helping to end homelessness one life at a time throughout the Lehigh Valley. Thousands have come to their shelter receiving life changing help.

The Allentown Rescue Mission continues to reinvent itself to address the increasingly complex root causes and issues of homelessness. Their shelter has been a place where men have begun to experience restoration.

The Laurel House is part of the Thistle Farms and Bloom community which provides sanctuary and a continuum of care to heal, empower, and employ women survivors of sex trafficking. This new location in Allentown will support pregnant survivors with 2 years of safety while they heal, deliver their child, attend parenting classes, and receive mentoring and vocational training in order to live independently.
