## Merry Christmas and Happy New Year!

As we wrap up December in the classroom, we also begin wrapping up the first half of the school year. The students have settled into the routines of classroom life and have started making friends with their peers as they practice sharing and taking turns. At Neffs UCC Preschool, we focus as much time on teaching self-help skills and social skills as we do early literacy

and early math skills. The holidays are an excellent time to help reinforce these skills at home and in the community. If you have a young child in your life, it is never too early to model and reinforce manners such as saying "please' and "thank you". You can have your young child help you "write" a thank-you card for a Christmas present by either drawing a picture for the person or having the child try to sign his/her name at the bottom of a letter you have written and read to the child. Children can help make and wrap gifts for community helpers such as the mail carrier, the fire department, or the teller at the bank. By taking an active part in the gift giving process, children learn to express gratitude and show respect for others in the community whose service often goes without notice. During this busy time when we all have more to do than hours in the day to complete, it is easy to brush past others or let the long lines flare our temper. Remember, the children around you are watching and learning from our action, so slow down, take a deep breath and take to heart the saying "Peace on Earth and Good Will towards Men."


