## Family Promise of the Lehigh Valley

**Mission:** to assist families with children experiencing or about to experience homelessness find or retain affordable housing, and gain sustainable, financial stability.

**Partners:** The mission is carried out by a network of 15 host congregations and many other community resources working together to meet the immediate, basic needs of displaced families and assist them to build patterns that will bring long-term stability.

**Motto:** We provide security, stability, and support in a judgment-free environment that recognizes that at any point, any one of us could be in their shoes.

**Impact:** 74% of the families utilizing this program find stable housing after 6 to 8 weeks.
