
Preparing for New Life

Guide their feet as they move through life, protecting them and guiding them. Help them see others through your eyes and be your heart and hands in the world, we pray. Amen.


10:30 Mornings with Ms. Tiffany (there will be NO Mornings with Ms. Tiffany on June 11)

Finally, the moment has arrived! The butterfly launches into its new environment — the heights that are now possible through transformation into what it was always meant to be. From Mark 2: 1-5: When he returned to Capernaum after some days, it was reported that he was at home. So many gathered around that there was no longer room for them, not even in front of the door, and he was speaking the word to them. Then some people came, bringing to him a

paralyzed man, carried by four of them. And when they could not bring him to Jesus because of the crowd, they removed the roof above him, and after having dug through it, they let down the mat on which the paralytic lay. When Jesus saw their faith, he said to the paralytic, "Child, your sins are forgiven."

HOLY COMMUNION

Everyone is welcome to this meal of love and grace. You will be served in your seats. Please wait to eat and drink until the Pastor invites you to do so.

If you are at home, we invite you to find something to eat and drink that represents communion for you.

A non-gluten option with juice is available in a prepackaged container on the bread tray. Both red wine and white grape juice are on the tray of cups. Please choose either.

Leader: The Transforming God be with you.

People: And also with you! Leader: Lift up your hearts.

People: We lift them up to the Living One.

Leader: Let us give thanks to the Lord our God! People: It is right to give our thanks and praise.

Leader: It is right, and a good and joyful thing, always and everywhere to give thanks to you, Creator of All That Is.

You formed us in your image and breathed into us the breath of life, imbuing us with all we need to navigate this life, to fly in the face of fear.

When we doubt our ability to imagine our way out of despair, we have often turned away from you, instead of toward you.

You have time and again delivered us from our captivity to hopelessness, made covenant to be our sovereign God, and have spoke to us through your prophets.

Leader: Holy are you, and blessed is your Son Jesus Christ.

His life and ministry offered us a vision
of the DNA of Love also instilled in us,
waiting for us to transform into those who will follow him.
Your Spirit anointed him
to preach good news to the poor,
to proclaim release to the captives

and recovering of sight to the blind,
to set at liberty those who are oppressed,
and to announce that the time had come
when you would save your people.
He healed the sick, fed the hungry, and ate with sinners.
By the baptism of his suffering, death, and resurrection
you gave birth to your church,
delivered us from slavery to sin and death,
and made with us a new covenant
by water and the Spirit.

When the Lord Jesus ascended, he promised to be with us always, in the power of your Word and Holy Spirit.

On the night in which he gave himself up for us, he took bread, gave thanks to you, broke the bread, gave it to his disciples, and said:

"Take, eat; this is my body which is given for you.

Do this in remembrance of me."

When the supper was over, he took the cup, gave thanks to you, gave it to his disciples, and said:

"Drink from this, all of you; this is my blood of the new covenant, poured out for you and for many for the forgiveness of sins. Do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of me."

And so, in remembrance of this love in Jesus Christ, we offer our love completely as we proclaim the mystery of faith.

All: Christ has died; Christ is risen; Christ will come again!

Leader: Pour out your Holy Spirit on us gathered here, and on these gifts of bread and wine.
