In October 2022 we invited 40 more leaders in our church to join us and formed the Leadership Planning Team. We have been meeting almost monthly looking at and creating a vision for God's ministry and mission at Union. In June 2023 we presented all of our work to Consistory who agreed to partner with us in our next steps.

Our Leadership Planning Team and Consistory met in October and November and will meet again at the Consistory meeting in January.

At November's Consistory meeting we committed to work on a marketing and outreach strategy and to increase Pastor Carrie's hours to support our first steps in offering more opportunities around wellness and mental health initiatives in our church and community.

We will share in a day long retreat on Saturday, January 27th to design a plan to implement next steps in our work together.

Baptisms: We offer baptisms during worship at the 10:30 service every other month. Our next date is **March 3 and May 19.** There is a pre-baptism zoom session with the pastor the week before. Hearing Assistance System: We have a wireless system on a table, as you enter from the lobby foyer. Please see an usher or a sound team person to assist you. You will need a receiver pack (turn it on) and ear piece (if you don't have a hearing aid) or a t-coil cord (if you have a hearing aid that is t-coil compatible.) Plug this into the receiver. At the end of worship, please return both pieces to the table and place the receiver back into the charger. Thank you to the Schlosser Family & Funds of Lasting Gifts for supporting this effort.

Food and Toiletry Donations: You're invited to bring non perishable food and toiletry donations at anytime to help our local food bank. Place items in the shopping cart in the lobby. Needed items: cereal, soup, pasta/sauce, peanut butter/jelly, vegetables, fruit, toothpaste/brush, shampoo, deodorant, soap, baby items. Thanks!
