What's a Chemo Port Pillow?

A chemo port pillow is a small pillow that a patient can Velcro around a car seatbelt or other shoulder strap to cushion and protect the port, typically implanted on the upper chest, used to deliver chemotherapy drugs. In the lobby, there is a tote collecting these port pillows for anyone who is interested in helping out this cause. These will be added into "Bags of Hope" provided from The Chemo Bag, given to chemotherapy patients around the Lehigh Valley.

This position focuses on serving and leading nursery age through elementary school age children and their families. Together with other staff and committees the Minister of Faith Formation creates a vision and implements a plan for Faith Formation (Christian Education) throughout all aspects of church and daily life.

Primary responsibilities include leading and organizing: the children's Education Hour on Sundays at 9:15am, Children's Church during 10:30am worship on Sundays, God First Wednesdays, additional monthly events and projects at times other than Sundays, mission and holiday projects, and Vacation Bible School in the summer.

Experience in teaching and/or teacher training is preferred, but relevant experience will be considered. **Hours:** Part-time, 18-20 hours/week, on-site office hours required but flexible, hours required for scheduled events on evenings and weekends, Sunday morning hours required. Other meetings required include staff meetings and committee meetings. Compensatory time available for busier and lighter times. **Compensation:** Salary (hourly rate) commensurate with education and experience.

Labyrinth Walks – at various times, open houses to stop by and retreat mornings or evenings.


Faith on Tap – a night of God, Food, and Drink at Kornfeind's Tavern with church and community friends.

Weeknight Lock Up: Union UCC is looking for someone who is trustworthy and reliable and interested in keeping our building safe and locked when not in use. We need this person to check every night Monday-Thursday evenings between 9 and 10pm and be available for occasional weekend evenings. Pay is \$11 for each lock up event (about 1 hour).
