After an extensive career as an educator and school administrator, she recently retired from serving as a school superintendent and has been discovering a new call in hospice and doula care. She would like to share her calling to care for others with our congregation by fulfilling some of the responsibilities of our Pastor of Spiritual Care.

All 101,088 meals provided during the recent LV MobilePack shipped out the week of November 3rd bound for the **Dominican Republic via our mission partner Cross Catholic Outreach.**



276 kids will be fed for a year!

Funeral Luncheon Hosts Needed Ardith Kuhns and Deb Sanek work with the Pastors to arrange for our church to host funeral luncheons for our members. They coordinate 2 volunteers to help to host a catered lunch for families. This ministry is so appreciated by our families. It allows them to enjoy a meal together with loved ones after a funeral in a familiar and relaxed setting at a reasonable cost.

We are looking for additional hosts. There is a stipend paid of \$25. Hosts are asked to arrive an hour before the luncheon to set up paper products, beverages, make coffee, and be available for the arrival of the caterer. They help to serve the meal, pack up leftovers for the family, and clean up the kitchen and hall area. This commitment is usually for about 3 hours.

We have a great team of hosts now who serve about 2-3 times a year. We would like to add to our team. If you are interested in offering warm welcome and hospitality to our families during their loss of a loved one please contact Pastors Kris or Kayli.



God First Wednesdays are for anyone and everyone. It's a great night to come if you can't be here on Sundays or if you have extra time to hang out with your church friends. We start with supper – usually a simple meal; mac and cheese, hot dogs, or spaghetti. There's always salad or a veggie and there's always a dessert.

Kids hang out and do activities with Miss Nikki, adults hang out with the pastors, and sometimes we do things all together. We close with a few minutes of prayer, singing, and reflection.

Suspicious Emails from Pastor Kris or Other Staff

We often have times when a fake email is generated by an outside scammer that looks like it's from Pastor Kris or other staff but it is not. The email address might look like hers – but if you look closely it is not her actual email. If it isn't pastorkris@unionucc.org then it isn't her email. So you should block it and delete it. It's tricky, because these scammers can also sound very much like her, using her ways of closing an email or phrases she uses, it's very deceptive. The email usually starts by asking for you to do a favor for her. When you respond it continues the request, like getting gift cards for someone whose ill. Directions include sending them a picture of the gift cards and the code. They do this so they can redeem them without the actual card.

So if you get an email that sounds like this – check the email or text first to be sure it is the real one. If you're still uncertain, contact the church office or Pastor Kris directly before you continue to respond. We will typically post on Facebook that a fake email has been sent, so you can also look there.

We are doing all that we can to continue safe and best practices with our technology. Unfortunately, this happens often to us and to Other churches. Thanks for your care and support.
